
Subject: To Encourage all Government Receipts and Payments through Digital Modes.

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Post-demonetization, the Government of Haryana had initiated a rigorous campaign to achieve the objective of transforming the State towards a digital and less-cash economy. Some of the important measures taken were i) Senior Secretaries to the Government were deputed to various Districts of the State for sensitizing the field officers as well as all the stakeholders such as bankers, traders, merchants, general public etc. to the benefits of digital transactions, ii) training programmes were organized for Government employees, iii) installation of Point of Sales (PoS) machines in various State Govt. Offices across the State in collaboration with State Bank of India to enable the citizens to pay fee, challans, fines etc. through debit/credit cards. Instructions have also been issued in the past to promote digital/cashless mode of payments, digitization of treasury vouchers, digitization of Govt. receipts and payments etc.

2. The State Govt. Departments/Boards/Corporations/Autonomous Bodies need to further step up awareness creation efforts about the advantages of cashless transactions amongst the citizens and encourage them to adopt the same in right earnest to ensure that the State quickly becomes a less-cash society and adopts digital economy in a big way, in consonance with the national digitization drive.

3. You are, therefore, requested to take all requisite steps, including incentives, to ensure that all receipts and payments in your organization are made through digital modes only.
